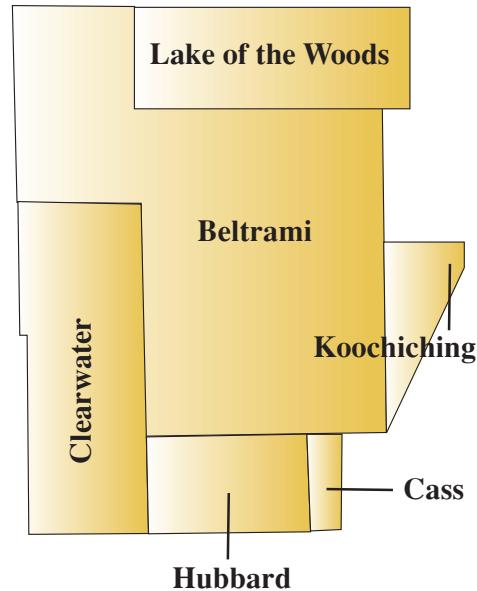

Northwoods Caregivers is a non-profit agency that has been providing community based services for 20+ years.

Home Health Services provides skilled, non skilled, and maintenance visits from a Registered Nurse along with Home Health Aide assistance with ADLs (Activities of Daily Living).

Home Health Services provide assistance that allows clients to remain in their home and independent while receiving the care they need.

Our Home Health Providers

In order to ensure the safety of our clients, all of our Home Health Providers must pass an extensive background check (criminal, personal and professional references).

Additionally each of our Home Health Providers has experience working with seniors and those living with special needs. All staff receive specialized dementia training and are supervised by a Registered nurse.

Who is Eligible to Receive Home Health Care?

Home Health Care and RN Services are available for a maximum of one hour per visit. Services can be paid by Private pay, Long Term Care Insurance, or through a variety of County Alternative Care/Elderly Waiver programs.

Benefits of Home Health Services

You will be assured that your needs are being met by professionals with knowledge that will assess chronic conditions and help to coordinate your care.

Preparing for Home Health Services

Decide whether you need occasional or regularly scheduled Home Health Care Services and what those services include. The first step includes an in person assessment.

Once services have started, you and your providers will arrange a time in advance for future RN or Home Health visits.
