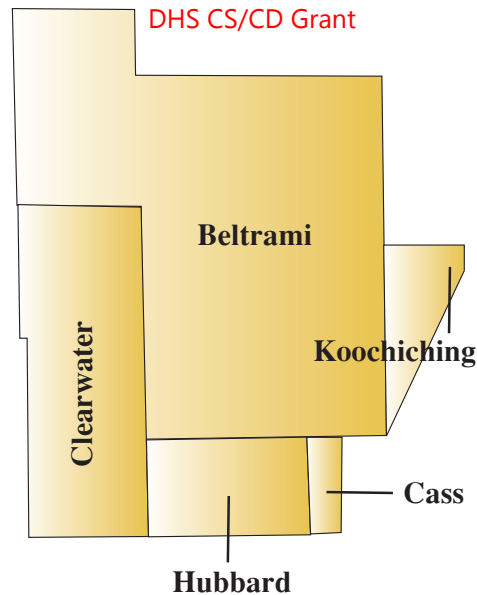

Our Respite Providers

In order to ensure the safety of our clients, all of our Respite Providers must pass an extensive background check (criminal, personal & professional references). Additionally, each of our Respite Providers is at the minimum a Certified Nursing Assistant and has the experience and training working with seniors and those living with special needs.

Who is Eligible to Receive Respite Care?

All Primary Caregivers who are caring for an elderly family member, friend or other loved one are welcome to receive our Respite Care. Services are available for a minimum of 2 hours on a private pay basis, through their long Term Care Insurance, subsidized through Title IIIIE funds or through a variety of County Alternative Care/Elderly Waiver programs through the counties Northwoods Caregivers serves.

Benefits of Respite Care

You will be relaxed, refreshed and rested.

You will have the assurance that your loved one is safe and being well cared for.

You will stay involved with other friends, family and your community.

Preparing for Respite Care

Decide whether you need occasional or regularly scheduled Respite Care.

When you have chosen a Respite Provider, arrange a time in advance for them to become acquainted with your care receiver and the household.

Provide clear instructions and a contact in case of emergency.
