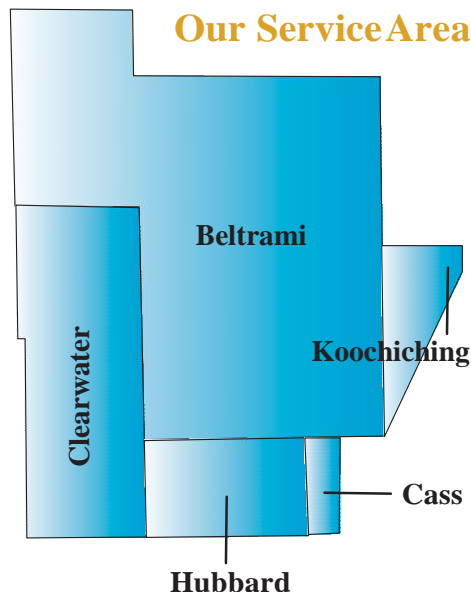

Who is Eligible to Receive Our Services?

Receiving services from Northwoods Caregivers is easy. A staff member will visit with each prospective client and/or family member and identify specific needs and recommend the appropriate services. An application is available online or can be mailed out.

Services are available on a private pay basis, a Sliding Fee, or through a variety of County Alternative Care/Elderly Waiver programs through the counties Northwoods Caregivers serves.
