Guardian ad Litem Program

A Guardian Ad Litem provides advocacy for children by gathering information to make recommendations in court regarding their best interest. Most cases are related to allegations of child abuse and/or neglect, family violence or marital dissolution proceedings. Unlike the other participants, the Guardian Ad Litem has no interest other than that of the child.

The Guardian Ad Litem's job is to ensure that the child is protected, to ensure that a stable home is provided, and to ensure that a thorough family assessment is made.

Guardian Ad Litem's conduct interviews and observe the children and significant people in their lives. They review social service, medical, school, psychological and criminal records and reports. They attend meetings with the other professionals involved with the children and their families. They outline options and make written and oral recommendations in court regarding the short and long term best interests of the children. They monitor court ordered plans to ensure the children's best interests are being met.

Several of our Homemakers have been testing a new (electronic) system over the last few months. Rather than filling out paperwork for each Homemaking visit, they have a hand-held, electronic Tablet and ask their clients to sign their name at the end of the visit. This is merely a confirmation that the service was provided to the client (similar to when the UPS man asks you to sign for a package!). We are also looking at implementing a similar system for all Respite Providers.

We are grateful to the George W. Neilson Foundation for a \$5,500 grant which will allow us to purchase the remaining Tablets for our Homemakers and Respite Providers. As we work towards transitioning to a more "paperless" system, feel free to call our office with questions or concerns!

Initialing & Signing

If you are a Client receiving Homemaking and or Respite Care Services, please remember you are responsible for reviewing the details of your Provider's visit (whether it's paperwork or the new electronic Tablet). We ask that you initial and/or sign off on the visit **ONLY** if the information is complete and correct!
